The Supreme Court of Canada rules on the RHUMART® self-therapy system

FREE WORLD TRUST prepares to market the system internationally

Background

First of all, a brief reminder that the action of the RHUMART® system is based on **the electrophysiology of the nervous system** and the regulating role it plays in **harmonizing the biological functions** of the body.

This self-care system was invented and patented by Dr. Roland A. Drolet, Ph.D.. In October 1975, Dr. Drolet founded Rodrol Instrumentation Inc., and in the early 1980's, he began marketing the first RHUMART® systems.

Later on, Bioelectrique-Medicine Inc. (MBI) and a few other authorized distributors began to market RHUMART® systems, primarily in Canada. Today, **Free World Trust (FWT)** is preparing a major campaign to market this self-care system worldwide.

Acknowledged effectiveness

This self-therapy system has proven its worth to hundreds of thousands of users around the world. In fact RHUMART® owners and other users have acknowledged without reservation that this system has helped them control hundreds of health-care problems, including arthritis, osteoarthritis, STRESS, chronic and acute pain, fractures, bursitis, injuries, wounds, burns, poor circulation, ulcers, varicose veins, high blood pressure, backaches, sprains, insomnia, migraines, osteoporosis, herpes, Crohn's disease, glaucoma, and premature aging.

Regenerating and Anti-STRESS effects

The RHUMART® system stimulates the natural, bioelectric and self-healing mechanisms of the human body. Its three major physiological effects are as follows: improved blood circulation; relaxation of the nervous system (with pain relieving and anti-inflammatory effects); and stimulation of normal cell regeneration and an overall anti-STRESS effect.

Commercial success

This therapy system has experienced great commercial success in Quebec, where more than 7,500 family systems were sold in the early 1990's.

Overall sales totalled some \$50 million (retail) during the initial marketing phase in Canada.

■ Three new patents on RHUMART® (Canada, U.S., and U.K.)

Free World Trust (FWT) holds all of the patents and trademarks related to RHUMART® technology. The three new patents issued on this modern self-therapy system are each 150 to 230 pages long: some thirty of the patent claims specify the exclusivity enjoyed by FWT at the international level. These three new patents of invention for the Self-Health™ system cover their methods of manufacture and control by microcircuits, microprocessors, microcontrollers, and integrated circuits. The operating procedures for the new RHUMART® system are also protected by the three new patents.

One encyclopedia and two compact disks (in seven languages)

Dr. Drolet recently supervised the creation of a seven-volume encyclopedia on the RHUMART® phenomenon. This work was published by iRi Publishing: P.O. Box 8645, Ste-Foy, Quebec, Canada G1V 4N6.

Two compact disks – the Golden RHUMART® CDs – have also been developed. Their audio and video content, in seven languages, also deal with the RHUMART® phenomenon and a wide variety of health problems. All this was done in preparation for **the impending world-wide marketing** of this self-therapy and self-care system.

The ruling of the Supreme Court of Canada

In December 2000, the highest court in Canada confirmed the validity of the first RHUMART® patents, which were issued a few years ago to protect the commercial exclusivity of these inventions in the field of regenerating bioelectricity and biomedical engineering.
